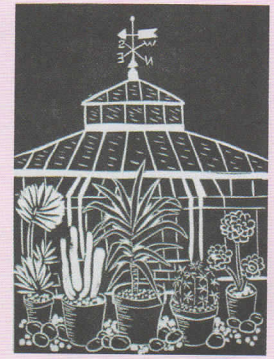
Inspirations of Broomfield:

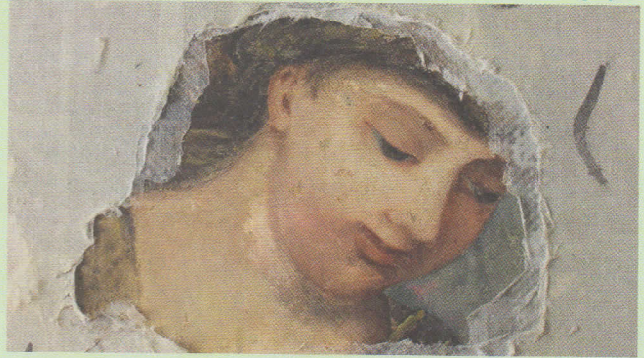
Bringing the Walls to Life:
